Completion of a 30 hour fine shading course that includes fingering and mock shading. The pattern should contain a minimum of three of the following five basic flowers: rose, morning glory, pansy, lily, daisy and three basic leaf shapes (one of which is a strap leaf)	N/A
Completion of two major rug hooking workshops (30 hours each) or four mini-workshops (of 15 hours each). The workshops should be taught by at least two different teachers. Exceptions may be granted for prospective students who do not have easy access to teachers. (The mini-workshops do not include such items as ornaments, purses, etc.)	N/A
Provide a certificate of completion (or letter from the workshop teacher) for each of the workshops	Yes
Submit a letter from a certified rug hooking teacher supporting your application to become a teacher	Yes
